“On one occasion, I heard these words: ‘My daughter, tell the whole world about My Inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. *The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the Divine floodgates through which grace flow are opened.*” (Diary of Saint Faustina, 699)

How to obtain a Plenary Indulgence for yourself or a soul in purgatory on Divine Mercy Sunday:

- The usual or standard three conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion, and prayer for the intentions of Supreme Pontiff.
- In any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy OR who, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus

FLAME OF LOVE PRAYER CENACLE

Beginning in early May, a Flame of Love Prayer Cenacle will begin meeting in our Church. The Cenacle will meet either weekly or bi-weekly in the afternoon or in the evening and will last approximately 90 minutes. The meetings will consist of a spiritual reading, short discussion and reflection followed by the Flame of Love Rosary and other Flame of Love prayers. Now is the time when prayer is most needed for the salvation of souls.

The Flame of Love is a gift of pure grace from God the Father, merited through the wounds of Christ, that were obtained by the plea of a Perfect Mother. It is gift for these times so that satan will be blinded and many souls will be saved. It is from the love within our transformed hearts that we want to share these graces with our families, friends, and church community.

The Flame of Love is truly shared heart to heart.
